REQUIREMENTS:

Grade 12 or equivalent qualification. Three years (3) of related experience, minimum of two years' work experience at the Northern Cape Theatre. Bachelor's degrees or certificate lighting design will be an added advantage. To work as a member of the Lighting team to deliver high quality technical services to productions at the Northern Cape Theatre. Execute all lighting duties at the theatre, with occasional sound and video as required. Knowledge of the use and maintenance of a range of professional lighting equipment. Experience of operating lighting consoles. Proficient in the use of Windows and Apple computer systems. Knowledge of professional lighting equipment. Ability to prepare, rig, focus, operate, maintain and troubleshoot lighting equipment, including followspots. Operate as lighting technician for performances including assisting with scene changes as required. Assist with rehearsals, show changeovers and performances ensuring they are executed smoothly and to time. Exceptional attention to detail. You must be prepared to work long and unsociable hours including evenings, weekends and holidays.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

To operate lighting & video in the Main House and other performance spaces. To provide support to the Back Stage Crew during fit ups and get outs. To work with creative teams and the technical staff to realise lighting and sound designs. To programme lighting desks in all spaces. To keep up to date with current lighting technology. To carry out lamp rounds and general maintenance, including keeping track of lamp stock in the theatres and front of house. To uphold and embody the Northern Cape Theatre policies. To actively participate in and support the training programme of the Northern Cape Theatre. To be an active and supportive member of the staff team. To provide the highest level of customer and audience care and service at all times. Perform any other reasonable duties as required to assist the production team. Maintain health and safety standard and practice of the Northen Cape Theatre.
